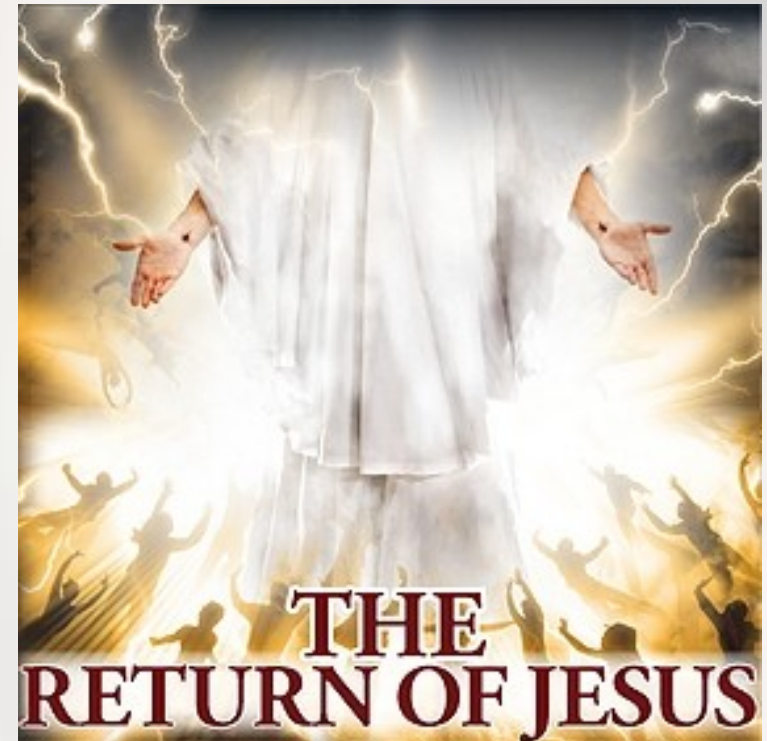

The Rapture and The Second Coming?

1 Thessalonians 4:17

Intro:

The rapture and the second coming of Christ are often confused. Sometimes it is difficult to determine whether a scripture verse is referring to the rapture or the second coming. However, in studying end-times Bible prophecy, it is very important to differentiate between the two. *1 Thessalonians 4:13-18* and *1 Corinthians 15:50-54*. *Revelation 19:11-16*.

I. The Differences Between the Rapture and Second Coming :

A. The Rapture of The Church

1. At the rapture, believers meet the Lord in the air.
1 Thessalonians 4:17
2. The rapture occurs before the tribulation.
1 Thessalonians 5:9; Revelation 3:10
3. The rapture is the removal of believers from the earth.
1 Thessalonians 4:13-17, 5:9
4. The rapture will be secret and instant.
1 Corinthians 15:50-54
5. The rapture is imminent; it could take place at any moment.
Titus 2:13; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; 1 Corinthians 15:50-54

B. The Second Coming of Christ

1. At the second coming, believers return with the Lord to earth.
Revelation 19:14
2. The second coming occurs after the great tribulation.
Revelation chapters 6-19
3. The second coming includes unbelievers judgment.
Matthew 24:40-41
4. The second coming will be visible to all.
Revelation 1:7; Matthew 24:29-30
5. The second coming of Christ will not occur until after certain other end-times events take place.
2 Thessalonians 2:4; Matthew 24:15-30; Revelation chapters 6-18

II. Why Keep The Rapture and The Second Coming Distinct?

- A. If the rapture and the second coming are the same event, believers will have to go through the tribulation.
1 Thessalonians 5:9; Revelation 3:10
- B. If the rapture and the second coming are the same event, the return of Christ is not imminent—there are many things which must occur before He can return.
Matthew 24:4-30
- C. In describing the tribulation period, Revelation chapters 6-19 nowhere mentions the church. During the tribulation—also called "the time of trouble for Jacob" (Jeremiah 30:7) — God will again turn His primary attention to Israel.
Romans 11:17-31
